Open Water Diver SCUBA Course

There's no greater adventure than Diving! Whether you're taking your first look at diving or you have been diving for years, there's always something new, fascinating or challenging about venturing into the underwater world.

The PADI Open Water Diver course will provide you with the knowledge and skills to enjoy recreational diving all over the world. You will be trained by a certified PADI Instructor with many years of experience training both adults and kids. In the program you will learn the safe and correct use of SCUBA using state of the art equipment that is well maintained to work at peak performance.

Course Outline:

The course consists of approximately 20 hours of instruction and qualifies for 1 College credit through ACE. The instruction is divided between knowledge development in the theory of diving and adapting to the underwater world, and pool sessions where you will learn the skills to dive. Each class is designed to increase your knowledge and understanding and build your confidence in diving. After completing the pool training and online course you will receive a referral form that qualifies you to finish the certification process at any location that offers the PADI certification. Upon completing the remainder of the course (four open water dives which are NOT included in this section of the course), you will receive the PADI Open Water Diver certification. This certification is recognized worldwide and allows you to participate with dive trips, dive clubs, rent/buy equipment, obtain air refills, etc.

Prerequisites:

Must be in good physical health, and able to swim 200 yards unassisted and tread water/float for 10 minutes.
